The Series is equipped with HDMI™ (x 3), PC and USB Type C video input terminals. LAN or serial control is possible, and simultaneous control and batch management can be performed via the network. The displays support LAN control with AMX or Crestron Connected™. The Series also supports Screen Transfer, which enables a PC to stream content to up to 64 displays connected with a wired LAN.
